The Nefyn & District ‘Conditions of Competitions’ will be in operation during the meeting. Copies are available in the Snooker Room, Locker Rooms, the Secretary Manager’s Office and the Professional’s Shop.

All Competitors should take note of the following:-

- Visitors and Members who have **NOT** declared Nefyn & District Golf Club as their Home Club for handicap purposes **MUST PRODUCE A CURRENT HANDICAP CERTIFICATE. PLAYERS WHO FAIL TO DO SO WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.** Would these competitors please put their handicap certificates in the appropriate card box in the Snooker Room. For full details please read the ‘**Conditions of Competitions**’ mentioned above.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any event.
- In the case of a dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
- Handicap limit for men will be 28 and for the ladies 36.
- Juniors are eligible to play in all competitions (except the Captain’s Prize) provided they hold a current CONGU handicap.
- Only one tee time can be reserved, no tee time can be changed once the Competition has commenced.
Certain times will be available to reserve on the Club web site www.nefyn-golf-club.co.uk ‘Book a Tee Time Online’ or www.brsgolf.com/nefyn/visitor_menu.php
- The names of all players must be entered on the time sheets – any gaps will be deemed available for any player to insert their names.
- All players are advised to put their current handicap certificates in the appropriate Gent’s and Ladies’ boxes in the Clubhouse.
- All Open Competitions are played on the New Course.

Players are expected to find their own partners and markers. Every effort will be made to assist those who fail.

Care of the Course

Holes in Bunkers.

Before leaving a bunker, a player should carefully fill up and smooth over all holes and footprints made while playing.

Replace Divots; Repair Ball-Marks & Damage by Spikes.

Through the green, a player should ensure any turf cut or displaced is replaced at once and pressed down, and that all pitch marks are repaired in the correct manner. Damage to the putting green caused by golf spikes should be repaired *on completion of the hole.*

Damage to Greens- Flagsticks, Bags, etc.

Players should ensure that, when putting down bags or the flagstick, no damage is done to the putting green and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing close to it, in handling the flagstick or in removing the ball from the hole. The flagstick should be properly replaced in the hole before the players leave the putting green. Players should not damage the putting green by leaning on their putters, particularly when removing the ball from the hole.

Damage through Practice Swings.

In taking practice swings, players should avoid causing damage to the course by removing divots, particularly on the tees.

Buggy / Caddy Cart

Members are requested not to take their buggy / caddy car on to the tees, or the aprons surrounding the greens.

Dress

Please observe the dress code, which is posted on notice boards in the Clubhouse as well in the Professional's Shop.
